

Elements of SYC/SYCSS Covid-19 Policy to Operate “On the Water” Events for 2021

Policy: It is the policy of the Saylorville Yacht Club and the SYC Sailing School to use the following elements for operating “on the water” events during 2021.

Definitions:

- Saylorville Yacht Club – “Club” or “SYC”
- Saylorville Yacht Club Sailing School – “School” or “SYCSS”
- Saylorville Lake Marina – “Marina” or “SLM”
- Staff – those persons assigned responsibility by the Club or School for an activity
- State Guidelines – those rules/recommendations currently in place as authorized by the governor for the state of Iowa
- CDC COVID-19 Symptoms – “CDC Guidelines” (see attached appendix as of 2.24.2021)

Plan Elements:

- All State of Iowa rules and Guidelines concerning COVID-19 will be followed as they become relevant for “on the water” activities.
- “At the slip” activities shall follow all current SLM guidelines.
- All events will be organized via email and 2-way Marine Band radios utilizing Channel 72 communications.
- Any and all on the waters group and/or in person meetings will be held only if allowed by both State and SLM policies and in accordance with such policies.
- Participation on boats will be organized by individual boat owners.
- Boat owners will limit the number of participants on the boat to the lesser of listed boat capacity, number needed for safe operation or the group size limitations of State Guidelines.
- Instruction classes will be accomplished using individual instruction or group size below the State Guidelines.
- Boats furnished for instruction by the School will be cleaned and disinfected by School Staff each day/use.
- For single and multi-day on the water events, participating individual(s) will provide their:
 - Name and contact information,
 - Acknowledgement of 14 days without CDC Symptoms,
 - Agree to a liability clause and must agree to follow all State Guidelines regarding social distancing, the use of a mask, and follow all SLM rules,
 - Agree to notify the event Club or School organizer/registrar if their health changes within the following 14 days,
 - Understands that limited sanitary facilities are available at the SLM at this time
- At this time NO sanitary facilities will be provided by the Club or School
- School and Club staff shall maintain final say on whether to sign out instruction boat(s) for use during on the water activities for racing and other on the water activities.


